- **UCF Student-Athlete's Graduation Rates Continue to Climb**

- **Academic Progress Rate (APR): What is it and how is UCF doing?**
  - Measures current student-athletes retention and eligibility/graduation
  - Overall score based on 4-year rolling cohort
  - Teams under 925 and 900 are subject to penalties (loss of scholarship – exclusion from participation in championship events)
  - 2008-09 data to be released in May by NCAA
    - UCF will have an average of 967 up 5 points from last year
    - All teams will be above 925 for second consecutive year
    - Teams with double digit improvement: Baseball (15), Football (12), Cross Country (16), Rowing (10), Indoor/Outdoor Track (20/19)
    - Since 2003-04 UCF teams have scored a perfect 1000 in a single year 22% of the time
