SUBJECT: RESOLUTIONS 1989-1990-13 and 1989-1990-14

I am responding to your April 2, 1990 memorandum. You requested that the Faculty Senate reconsider its actions on resolutions (89-90)13 and (89-90)14. The resolutions were passed by the 1989-1990 Faculty Senate which no longer exists. For the official senate records, we will record that the resolutions were rejected, and your letter to the faculty will be filed.
