

**University Honors Committee**  
**End-of-Year Report**  
**AY 2011-12**

Last year was very productive for the UHC. This committee met twice during the academic year as a great deal of business was conducted electronically. Below are the summaries for these two meetings:

**October 14, 2011**

Our main order of business was the evaluation of 16 Honors interdisciplinary seminars. The UHC made recommendations to approve five seminar proposals. Two proposals were approved with minor revisions and nine proposals were approved with major revisions.

**February 24, 2012 Meeting**

The UHC reviewed eight Honors interdisciplinary seminars and made recommendations to approve five seminar proposals. Three proposals were approved with major revisions.

Other actions were taken with regard to the selection of student scholarship recipients. Students were selected for the following scholarship programs:

Finally, for next year it was agreed that subcommittees of the UHC would be formed in order to review applicants for Honors scholarships.
