Summary of Meetings

The committee met four times in the Millican Hall, Room 395, during the 2014-15 academic year; twice in the Fall 2014 semester (October 23, 2015 & December 1, 2015) and twice in the Spring 2015 semester (January 20, 2015 & March 23, 2015). Each meeting lasted approximately 1 hour (see the committee minutes for additional details regarding attendees, dates, times, topics).
