- STARS (Showcase of Text, Archives, Research & Scholarship) institutional repository for faculty, staff, students, and affiliates of UCF to share work globally
- New Library Website improved easier access to services and searches
- Textbook Affordability –based on national/state legislation to improve textbook affordability for students
- Library Security Community Security Officer evening presence (Sun Thur)
- Library Materials Budget special funding received to meet budget needs
- New Integrated Library System (ILS)- Implemented under Florida Academic Library Services Cooperative (comprised of 12 universities and 28 colleges)
- Funded Tech Fee Proposals funded eight important resources
- Libraries Presence at UCF Downtown Campus print materials and online; cutting edge technology; study areas; intercampus loan capability; library staff
