

Faculty Center for Teaching and Learning Advisory Committee (Section VIII-D) 2016-2017 Annual Summary Report to Senate

Summary of Meetings

The FCTL Advisory Board met twice during the academic year 2016-2017. The first meeting was held on October 18, 2016 from 3:0-4:00 p.m. and the second on February 27, 2017 from 2:00-3:00 p.m. Both meetings were held in CB1-205. Travis Jewett, College of Medicine, served as chair this year.

Summary of Issues or Topics Addressed

The committee was informed about

- New FCTL model for Faculty Fellows (seven positions this year)
- New instructional specialist hire in December—Amanda Wolcott, Ph.D. in I/O Psych.
- Continued success of Faculty Center's program, "Student Consultants on Teaching"
- Goals for virtual faculty development
- Status of new learning spaces (CB1-220)
- Changes to FCTL's Institutional Effectiveness Plan
- Strategies for Advisory Board involvement
- New conference co-hosted by UCF and USF, The Sunshine State Teaching and Learning Conference
