### **2. Summary of Meetings**

The committee met four times during the 2016-17 academic year (Millican Hall, 395E & Tech Commons 1, Room 102C); twice in the Fall 2016 semester (September 9, 2016 & November 10, 2016) and twice in the Spring 2017 semester (February 27, 2017 & May 11, 2017). Each meeting lasted approximately 1 hour (see the committee minutes for additional details regarding attendees, dates, times, topics).

### **3. Summary of Issues or Topics Addressed**

Topics discussed during the meetings included (see the committee minutes for further information):

- Updates on Computer Services & Telecommunications (CST), now UCF IT features across campus (Transition to UCF IT, ServiceNow, Expansion of Office 365, Campus licensing for Adobe, OneDrive and Creative Cloud, Multifactor Authentication, Residential Life Network, and Faculty Excellence Awards moving to EPAP, and Advanced Threat Protection).
- Updates on Library Services across campus (21<sup>st</sup> Century Library Project, remote access to library resources, ARC construction, renovations, and integrated system).
- Updates from Center for Distributed Learning Services (UCF Online increasing access and reducing costs/fees, 42% of SCH were online modalities, New Adaptive Reduced Seat Time modality, and Adaptive Learning).
- Updates from Office of Instructional Resources services (timeline for addition of campus buildings, updating classrooms, and Sandbox – a mobile first space for active learning)
- Updates on Faculty Center for Teaching & Learning (Utilizing Adobe Cloud in GEP courses, licensing for all Faculty and Staff, transition to Archibus from PeopleSoft, and Creative Cloud).
- Updates from Space Planning and Analysis (New space database Archibus implementation, a university-wide Space Use and Allocation policy, Colburn Hall renovation, Research Building I, hoteling and flex spaces, and downtown academic building to be named Dr. Phillips Academic Commons)
- UCF High Performance Computing (report due end of semester)
- UCF Apps (Over 800 – need to rationalize and reduce redundancies)
- Emergency Notification System
- Software Licensing (and challenges)
