During the year, four meetings were held. The committee worked on SGA Resolution 52-39 which was passed in June 2020. The resolution encouraged UCF to adopt specific courses listed in the document to fulfill the Historical and Cultural Foundations GEP and Gordon Rule Writing Requirements. The committee worked with colleges on courses listed in the resolution to revise the curriculum to meet the GEP, Diversity, and Gordon Rule Writing requirement.
