Summary of Meetings

The FCTL Advisory Board met on September 22 from 12:00-1:00 to select subcommittees for members. The Recommendations subcommittee met on Oct. 24 from 9:00-10:30, Nov. 7 from 3:00-4:00, and on Feb. 27, from 2:00-3:00. The Awards subcommittee met on Jan. 24 from 1:30-3:00, and Feb. 7 from 1:20-2:30.

Summary of Issues or Topics Addressed

The Recommendations subcommittee discussed:

- Revisions to FAQs on teaching under HB7 (these deliberations were set aside when an injunction against the law was issued)
- Student Perception of Instruction possible new questions
- Continuing struggles to balance flexible policies with student accountability
- Need for more programming to address disengagement among faculty and students
