New Business

- II-A: Request to relocate 1 Service Vehicles Only Space for the Music Department. Relocate one of two service spaces currently located in parking H-4 to parking lot H-3 for better accessibility to the Performing Arts Center. Motion and second to approve, and was approved unanimously.
- II-B: Parking issues related to space reallocation for the Music Department due to the closing of parking lot H-1.
