New Business

- II-A: Request for a designated pick-up spot for take-out orders from Pollo Tropical. The request is for 1 space in parking lot B-10 with a 10 minute time limit. Effective from 11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. and from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. There was a move and second to approve this request and it was unanimously approved.
- II-B: Request for visitor parking spaces located in parking lot E-4 for softball guests. The request is for 2 dedicated visitor spaces for guests to be controlled by softball personnel. There was a move and second to approve this requests and it was unanimously approved.

III-D: Expectant mother spaces: Currently we have 21 active spaces

Discussion: Beginning January 2, 2018 Parking and Transportation Services will implement a van service to the Emerging Media Campus. There will be 2 morning runs and 2 afternoon runs.

In March of 2018, there will be some spaces recovered in parking lot H-2 and when the new bus terminal turn-a-round at the Interdisciplinary Building is complete, we will regain approximately 50 parking spaces.
