The meeting was called to order at 10:40 a.m.

The minutes of January 10, 2019 were approved.

New Business

- II-A: Request for parking permits to use for a raffle. Request from Samantha Davis and Jessica Bailey for two or more parking permits for the 2019-20 academic year for the annual Knight-Thon fund raiser. Permits will be entered in a silent auction, with the permit or permits being awarded to the highest bidder. Item tabled until next meeting.
- II-B: Parking designation in Libra Garage. Request from faculty member Mary Schmidt-Owens that Libra Garage be open to all permits on all levels. Libra Garage is designated as resident parking with exceptions. Currently there are 28 spaces on the first level designated for faculty and staff, and the top level is open to all permit designations. Parking Services recommends adding an additional 10 spaces on the first level, while additional parking spaces are being built at Facilities. The motion was unanimously approved.
- II-C: Review changes to 2019-20 parking regulations. The minor changes to the Parking and Transportation regulations were reviewed and amended. The committee will review any additional changes or recommendations at the next meeting.

Old Business

- III-A: Requests for reserved spaces
1. Sudipta Seal – Chair, Material Science Engineering. This request was unanimously approved
- III-B: Expectant Mother Spaces: As of the January meeting we had 25 active spaces
- During January 2019, 8 new spaces were added and 6 spaces were removed that were no longer needed.

Discussions: The student transportation contract is currently being evaluated with 4 bidders in contention for the contract. Contract with 10-year busses must be in place by July 1, 2020.
