- 1. Krishna Singh reviewed plans for new building on existing parking lot (H1).
 - a. This building will result in the loss of 115 student spaces, 10 disabled spaces, which will be moved to parking lot H4 and potential new lot on Centaurus Drive West at the bottom of Greek Park Drive. Parking for faculty would transition to PG I
 - b. New building to being construction in Summer 2017

- 3. Christos: Are there any plans to build a bridge (s) across Alafaya or Gemini Boulevard?
 - a. Krishna: It has been considered, but too expensive
- 4. Ahmad: How might we improve this committee's work?
 - a. Donna: Get technology to work in support of meeting before, during, and after?
