New Business

- II-A: Administer parking permits and enforce regulations effective fall 2018 at the Rosen Campus. Effective fall of 2018 Parking and Transportation Services will sell parking permits and enforce parking regulations at the Rosen Campus. They currently have 800 parking spaces for the students who are now enrolled and are expecting an enrollment of 4,500 students by 2020. No vote is required for this item.
- II-B: Request for 2 dedicated spaces for Psychology site clinic. There will be an office that will perform human research on aging cognition in the Interdisciplinary Building once it is open. They are asking for 2 spaces in the vicinity that will accommodate those patients. Move in is scheduled for mid-March. There was not a quorum of voting members in attendance; therefore, this item will be discussed at the next meeting.
