1. Scooters on Campus and Safety - - Kris Singh:
Kris mentioned that there are about 300 scooters currently on campus and are available to rent for \$1 to unlock. Those are on trial for one year and the number will increase to have eventually 500 of those before the end of the semester. Speeds are variable depending on the location, ranging from 12 miles per hour to 5 miles per hour. Faculty and staff may also use the scooters if they want. There are some insurance issue that regulate the operation of the scooters regarding falls, damage to property, etc.
2. Golf Carts Speed Limits - - Follow-up by Andrea Gandy:
Policy is still in the making regarding golf carts and other slow-moving utilities (utility vehicles). Efforts are in place to identify standards for installing odometers and speedometers (maybe). We will need to check back in the Fall semester.
