#### **Introduction and Initial Business**

Richard Hartshorne called the meeting to order. The first item of business was approval of the minutes for the January ITRAC meeting. Richard Hartshorne administered the approval process and the minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

#### **Discussion of Electronic Process for Annual Report, Lyman Brodie**

UCF is looking to make the faculty annual report process part of the eP & T system. Everything for P & T will be electronically submitted and completed.

#### **Demonstration of Online Annual Report System, David Canova & Ron Mathews**

The eFAR (electronic faculty annual report) system was demonstrated. Colleges can modify approval/workflow. This is only a pilot now, and functionality (importing, linking with ARGIS, linking to SPIs) is being added. Concerns were voiced regarding the amount of flexibility needed for such a tool to be useful. The committee was advised to send all questions/concerns/suggestions to Lyman Brodie.

#### **Software Licensing Challenges, Larry West**

At this point, it was asked whether this is important/clear enough to be discussed. This is a very complex issue, to the point that UCF has hired a person to address what the University is doing to improve licensure issues (Jon-Paul Estes). The committee was advised to go back to colleges and get issues/questions related to licensure for the next meeting.

#### **Eduroam, Bob Yanckello**

An Executive Summary of Eduroam was disseminated to the committee. Currently, the addition of Eduroam is not on UCF's schedule, but may be added in the near future (12-18 months). Comments from the committee were solicited, and the committee was advised to explore the Executive Summary. A summary of Eduroam will be provided in the next meeting.

Richard Hartshorne asked for suggested topics to be discussed in future meetings. The summary of Eduroam was suggested, as well as a discussion of the design of the Library site.
