### **New Business**

- II-A. Permits for Air Force ROTC Faculty and Staff Air Force staff requested that they be issued 9 parking permits at no cost, given that the Air Force no longer covers the cost of campus parking. After discussion, there was a motion and second to allot 9 permits to the Air Force staff who are not UCF personnel. The request was unanimously approved.
- II-B: Permits for Army ROTC Faculty & staff -- Army ROTC staff requested that they be issued 21 parking permits at no cost, given that the Army no longer covers the cost of campus parking. After discussion, there was a motion and second to allot 21 permits to the Army staff who are not UCF personnel. The request was unanimously approved.
- II-C: Request from Naomi Morris for incremental permit fees for portions of a semester. Item tabled for further discussion.
- II-D: Parking for NA (Narcotics Anonymous) at Barbara Ying Center. Request that ticketing for No Permit in parking lot B-7 be suspended each Wednesday evening between the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. to facilitate this program as well as on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month (same time frame) for Celebrate Recovery meetings. Item was unanimously approved.
- II-E: Request to add a disabled parking space near RWC. There's only one space in the vicinity and there are three disabled persons working in the RWC that require a disabled space. The request was unanimously approved.

Information: UCF will have 2 parking lots (A & B) for parking downtown. Parking Services will sell faculty, staff and student permits to those who work downtown and park in these lots. Signage will be installed prior to the beginning of classes and Parking Services will provide enforcement to ensure that only permitted vehicles may park in these lots.

An annual fee of \$1,500 will be assessed to the apartment complexes who participate in the shuttle program which will offset miscellaneous costs associated with operating the shuttles.

The parking lot at the Greek Life Housing area currently being used for construction vehicles, will be enhanced to help off-set loss of parking in parking lot H-1.
