New Business

II-A: HEV Charging Stations – charging for usage of the charging stations using an App through a company such as Sema Connect. It is expected that by the end of next year there will be at least 17 charging stations located throughout the campus. The charging stations are currently limited to 4 hours for charging. The proposal is to charge \$1.00 - \$1.50 per hour to re-coup cost for maintenance of the stations and energy used. There would be an increased amount charged should the vehicle remain in the spaces more than the 4 hour limit. Committee members will take the proposal back to constituents for feed-back.

Trevor Colbourn Hall Construction – The construction of Trevor Colbourn Hall is scheduled to II-B: begin during the summer of 2017, which will impact 10 disabled, 2 24- hour reserved and 114 faculty parking spaces located in parking lot H-1. The 10 disabled parking spaces are scheduled to be moved to parking garage I. Tabled for further review.

They would not want any signage to have reference to SGA or the SGA logo. He has done a survey and had 747 responses; 70% were students who live off campus and 30% were students who live on campus.
