### **MAIN DISCUSSION**

1. Approval of Minutes: Moved (Frazee), Seconded (Loerzel). Unanimous approval
2. Review of Topics for Discussion from 2016-2017 Faculty Senate – Parking Costs were the #1 complaint from the COACH subcommittee on personal & family policies. Need options to reduce parking fees for faculty. FSU has flat rate of \$250/yr. with new license plate system. UCF faculty pay almost \$100 more than FSU
3. There was a discussion initiated by Frazee about the rationale for cost of parking decals as they are today and perhaps we bring more information to explain cost differential from other institutions
4. Sawyer explained some history of how pricing is set, including cap on student fees, noting that decreases in decal prices would have to be offset in other ways. He noted that decal fees at UCF are consistent with USF and UF; at UCF, there have been no decal fee increases since Fall 2011; no increase in the transportation access fee since Fall 2012; and a recent reduction in the difference between hang tag and sticker decal.
5. It was noted that Parking Services is planning for capital expense associated with parking and shuttle service to support the downtown campus. Also plans for regular maintenance of on-campus garages.
6. Elshennawy asked whether this committee should be extended to include transportation safety on-campus, in light of concerns about skateboards, bikes, and golf carts.
7. Sawyer noted that the University monitors campus safety in several ways. Lee Kernek is responsible for policies re: skateboards, bikes, etc. Campus police department handles concerns about bikes.
