 - **Mission:** The Budget and Administrative Committee evaluates and recommends policies and procedures concerning the university budget with special emphasis on the academic budget.

 - HR – Policy 3-002 Salary Overpayment Penalty revised to clarify recovery fees from units related to delays in reporting payroll changes and matches language to Workday
 - **Charge of committee this year:** Faculty Training requirements — Each year, faculty spend significant amounts of time completing repetitive and overlapping training programs to meet various statutory and regulatory requirements. The Compliance and Ethics Advisory Committee identified well over 100 different possible training requirements across campus. What can be done to combine, consolidate, plan, and organize the various training programs to minimize the administrative burden on faculty? This is especially burdensome for adjunct faculty members, who receive no compensation for the extensive training required just to teach a single course.
 - **Other major interest:** Change Management for Technology Transitions — The Committee seeks methods to ensure a smoother adoption process for new tools (e.g., Simple Syllabus, Interfolio, Leganto) and roll out of procedures for their use.
