- Call to order at 2:03 pm
- Approval of the Minutes for May 16, 2023 Meeting
  - Accepted
- Review Old Business
  - Knightsmail Transition
    - Matt Hall gave a review of the summer's efforts to move students from Knightsmail to UCF.edu
    - Transition was completed successfully
    - Denise Kay mentioned a fall-off they have noticed in College of Medicine on use of ucf.edu email (versus with knightsmail) but could be new semester
- New Business
  - Artificial Intelligence Usage in Research
    - Started a discussion of good and bad uses of AI within research (not teaching)
      - Do all faculty know AI? Should there be training for competency?
      - AI as a disruptor
        - Students (and faculty even) may need different skills in the future
        - Effects on UCF workforce
      - Access to big data and new types of data
    - Uses
      - In writing proposals
        - Even introductions for an advanced topic do not work that well
      - In ideas
        - Does not seem good at producing anything new or original; just re-phrasing stuff already available
          - "Stochastic Parrot"
    - Concerns
      - Plagiarism

- Could faculty or departments that submit heavily AI-written work to funding agencies or journals end up getting sued or penalized in some way?
- Job security for faculty and staff in AI?
- Data Use
  - What data can you use to train your AIs? Does that change if you intend to monetize the result?
  - Can you use AI in authoring your papers (many publishers now prohibit it)?
    - Point was made that you really need to trust that the paper draft from your student was not AI generated
  - How do you control what happens to your data and papers and whether it is ingested?
  - There is a perception that you can take any papers etc that you can access and use it for training the AIs. The Office of General Counsel is examining the issue currently.

  - There's also another group looking at AI that's made of representatives from CDL, Library, and faculty.
