## 4. Old Business

a) Andy Singh mentioned that the scooters that are contracted with the University along with the golf carts have speedometers that are governed at 10mph. This does not apply to the private means of conveyance that the students and others use on campus, but they are "working on that". Parking passes that expire in Aug 31 will be honored until Dec 31. There are no current concerns with finding parking spaces on campus due to lowered capacity and less face-to-face learning. For the shuttle service, riders will have to present ID.

- a) Adam Walsh brought up the cut to the police department was facing budget cuts (9%?).
  - i) Elizabeth Hamilton informed the committee that Public Safety's recurring budget is \$12.6 million, which did not change from last year, and Public Safety is not part of the division's six percent budget reduction plan. There were about \$1 million in non-recurring allocations supplemental to Police Department budget in FY20, but those non-recurring allocations were primarily for one-time items not needed in FY21. This will be outlined at the Senate meeting on Thursday along with other budgetary concerns.
